Lighthouse Academy offers The Harbor - Day Treatment Program to enrolled students who qualify.

Each day, students complete 4-5 hours of academic instruction with a certified Teacher and 1-2 hours of individual and group therapy with a trained therapist.

Upon completion of the Harbor program, students are given the option to transfer into the Community School or return to their home district and continue working toward their High School diploma.

Career Technical Job Skills and Training

Lighthouse Academy academic programs serve students in Kent, Muskegon and Ottawa county who may otherwise not have a chance to graduate high school. Programs are designed to support students who are or have been:

- Expelled from school
- Long-term Suspended
- Court Referred
- IEP Placed (through home school district or county ISD)
- Unaccompanied minor refugees
- Aged Out Young Adults (19 -22 years old)

Through our partnership with **Ferris State** University, the Early Middle College is provided to students as a career readiness program at no cost to students or their











families. 11th grade students can choose one of four programs which count toward both a High School Diploma and an Associate degree or college credits. All classes are held onsite at Lighthouse Academy. Lighthouse Academy participates with

Kent Career Technical Center where students can earn Certificates in a industry of their choice. Additionally, students are offered Work Based Learning, Job Skills, Career Cruising and the possibility of job placement
